## One Step Closer to Funding for an Adult Dental Benefit in Medicaid

The Virginia Senate included funding for a comprehensive adult dental benefit in Medicaid in their budget this legislative session. This means we are one step closer to securing funding for an adult dental benefit. However, there is more work to be done.

The Senate budget and the House budget, which did not include funding for an adult dental benefit, are now in conference committee. Catalyst has a simple <u>3-2-1 advocacy initiative</u> that you can take part in right now to help secure funding:

- <u>Three:</u> Send three emails to conferees. Catalyst created an email template with contact information for each conferee so you can easily send at least three emails.
- <u>Two:</u> Call two conferees. Use Catalyst's phone script to call at least two conferees to show support for an adult dental benefit.
- **One:** Share one Catalyst social post. Throughout the conference process Catalyst has shared on its social channels how a dental benefit will improve health outcomes and lower costs. Share a social post with your network to build awareness.

#### **Resources Available to Improve Census Count**



A federal census count is happening in 2020; data from the census will impact everything from representation in government to funding for important public health programs. In years past, the census has disproportionately undercounted groups of color and individuals with disabilities. Because the census only takes place once every ten years it is important to get an accurate count of all Virginians so funding for public

programs can be distributed accurately. There are a number of resources available to help health advocates and community members raise awareness about the importance of completing the census forms, including materials from <u>Governor Northam's office</u> and <u>The Arc</u>.

#### Virginia State Loan Repayment Program is Accepting Applications

The Virginia Department of Health is accepting applications for the Virginia State Loan Repayment Program. Applications will be accepted through March 31. The program grants loan repayment in exchange for at least two years of service in a Health Professional Shortage Area in Virginia. Learn more about eligibility and how to apply <u>here</u>.
