# **Returning to Dentistry Live Q&A Resources:**

### **Return to Work Guidelines:**

Virginia Health Catalyst is monitoring guidelines at the state and national levels. As additional information is learned, guidelines will be updated appropriately.

#### **Association Guidelines:**

- <u>ADA Return to Work Interim Guidance Toolkit</u> The ADA has released a
  free toolkit for clinicians preparing to see patients during and after COVID19. The toolkit includes guidance and recommendations to keep patients
  and staff safe.
- <u>ADHA Interim Guidance on Returning to Work</u> The ADHA has developed this document to provide interim guidance to dental hygienists on returning to work.
- <u>VDA Interim Guidelines for Re-entry</u> The VDA has released its guidelines for re-entry. The guidelines include recommendations like staggering appointments, and continuing to use teledentistry.

#### **Federal Guidelines:**

- <u>CDC Updated Infection Control Guidelines</u> The CDC is updating its guidelines, including the Interim Infection Prevention and Control Guidance for Dental Settings with new information and recommendations.
- OSHA Guidance for Dentistry Workers and Employers This document includes updated guidance for dentistry workers who are at greater risk of occupational exposure of COVID-19.
