Front Line Innovations Blog Series - Policy Changes to Improve Oral Health

This week Governor Northam reported nearly 30,000 adults in Virginia have enrolled in Medicaid since March. In our latest Front Line Innovations blog, Pat Finnerty, Catalyst's policy committee chair and a former director of the state's Medicaid program looks at federal policy innovations that could improve access to oral health care in Virginia for the over 400,000 adults enrolled in Medicaid.

The most recent <u>blog</u> in the series provides an overview of federal policy innovations that, if enacted, could support state efforts to improve access to oral health services. Specifically: an increase to the Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP), and funding for state health departments and oral health programs to support oral health infrastructure. Pat shares how these policies could improve access to oral health care now and in the future.
