<p>Meeting Objectives</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Review key decisions to date Consensus on the data collection and analysis approach for the remaining four indicators Introduce the December meeting topic
<p>Consensus Items</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Most participants (92%) voted to display ‘in development/coming soon’ for the two indicators related to third graders (percent with sealants on their permanent molars, and percent who have experienced tooth decay). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> At this time, only the 2014-2015 data used in the previous Report Card are available; the Basic Screening Survey used to obtain these data will be conducted again in 2022. This context will be addressed in the Companion Narrative An updated report card will be distributed once these data are available The group approved the analysis approach (with no changes) for the fluoridated water systems, and medical providers applying fluoride varnish indicators.
<p>Development Questions and Considerations</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore the feasibility of obtaining claims data to measure the prevalence of dental sealants and/or tooth decay among third graders. Thank you to Nia Harrison for recommending alternative data sources for the group’s review.
