


**2022 Virginia Oral Health Report Card

<p>Meeting Objectives</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Review Report Card development process and workgroup roles Consensus on the data year for Report Card and Companion Narrative Consensus on the data collection and analysis approach for five indicators
<p>Consensus Items</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Participants reported they were comfortable with the proposed 2022 Report Card analysis approach (where data are available/sufficient): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> CY/SFY19 data for the Report Card Trending from SFY 2016-2019, breakouts by region and race/ethnicity and summary on the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic in the Companion Narrative Most participants (62%) voted to change the <i>Children and Teens aged 1-20 who had a preventive dental visit through Medicaid</i> to age group 3-20. This would remove the overlap in population with the <i>Children aged 1-2 who had a preventive dental visit through Medicaid</i> measure. The group had no changes to the <i>Adults with Tooth Loss</i>, <i>Adults with Dental Coverage</i> and <i>Pregnant Women who Visited the Dentist</i> measures, and approved the approach to highlight system changes (e.g Medicaid Expansion) in the Companion Narrative.
<p>Development Questions and Considerations</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore the feasibility of including breakouts by disability category for each measure Explore the use of the Virginia All Payer Claims Database for the current fluoride varnish measure, and for a potential new measure-emergency department utilization for dental concerns Explore the development of non-Report Card oral health indicators within other Catalyst initiatives
